



## Civil Courage Prize Criteria

1. Steadfast non-violent resistance over time is key.
2. "At great personal risk" means imprisonment, torture, death threats or worse.
3. The honoree, or their proxy, should be available to collect the Prize in person and deliver an address at the ceremony.
4. The focus of the prize is resisting evil rather than defending human rights or fighting corruption. It is not a peace prize or a humanitarian prize.
5. "Evil" will probably be monstrous.
6. It will focus on the recent past more than the distant past.
7. Worthy nominations are carried forward for future consideration.
8. Self-nominations are not accepted.
